RaeAnn Thomas shared information about a charity she has created called For One Child of India (FOCI). FOCI was created to help families in Tamil Nadu India to find a future out of poverty. FOCI operates to facilitate access to education for impoverished children, because it is education that will empower those children to grasp opportunities and create lives for themselves filled with dignity and self-determination. You can help FOCI to help poor children in India by donating to this 501(c)3 charity on a one time basis, or by committing to sponsor a specific child for the duration of their education. FOCI families live in small villages, they own very little and perform "cooley" labor, working on demand for a very low daily wage, weeding the paddy, sugarcane, or peanut fields by hand. They live each day striving to meet just the needs of that day. They have little or no opportunity to plan for the future. FOCI strives to change all that.
