Program: Monarch Butterfly Updates



Kathy McGrath is a retired kindergarten teacher from Port Edwards. She taught for 34 years in the Port Edwards School System, which 31 of those years she taught kindergarten. She did the monarch project with her kindergartners when she was still teaching. Once she retired she was able to devote more time to the monarchs. She and her husband, Pat, have raised thousands of monarchs over the years. During the summer of 2018 they raised and released a record 1,386 monarchs and tagged 300 of them for their migration to Mexico. She will share certificates that they have received because some of their tagged monarchs have been recovered in Mexico. Her presentation dealt with the life cycle of the monarch, how to get involved in raising monarchs and what you can do to help them.

In early 2017 she was instrumental in getting Port Edwards designated as the first Monarch Village in the United States. The 2nd annual Monarch Festival was held in Port Edwards on Saturday, August 11, 2018.
