Program: Update on the YMCA/Boys & Girls Club Project

Phil Brown was in charge of today's program and with the assistance of fellow Rotarians Bret Salscheider and Kent Anderson they gave an update on the YMCA/Boys & Girls Club project. Phil gave some opening remarks focusing on past projects in the south Wood County area which included building a new Riverview Hospital in the 1960s and the South Wood County 2000 campaign in the 1990s. The effort to repurpose the Rapids Mall area is the biggest capital campaign our community has seen in a long time. Bret then gave some details of the project and showed the campaign video and a 3D flyover video. Kent then reviewed the collaborative efforts of bringing the YMCA and the Boys & Girls Club under one roof and how it enhances serving the youth and health and wellness of our community.
