Founded in 1993 by John and Patty Noel of Stevens Point, Make A Mark Foundation is a non-profit, humanitarian foundation that funds sustainable building projects such as clinics, schools and orphanages in developing countries. As a result of the devastating AIDS pandemic, millions of orphans and vulnerable children are being left to fend for themselves in sub-Saharan Africa. Make A Mark is working with a coalition of partners and NGOs (non-governmental organizations) to create a lasting solution to the growing orphan crisis.
