Ron Rasmussen the principal at Wisconsin Rapids Lincoln High School (LHS) provided an update to the Club on the recent additions and renovations at LHS.

1. Added auxiliary gym, which can be used for the gymnastics and wrestling programs.
2. Expanded the girls' locker room, same size as when it was built in 1979.
3. Added a College and Career Center area, which will be a help students prepare for their future education/careers.
4. Renovated the kitchen serving area, as not done since 1979. Approximately 65% -75% of high school students eat hot lunch at LHS.
5. Replaced pool with an eight-lane pool. The depth on the shallow end was increased to the WIAA requirements, which now will allow for large-scale tournaments to be held at the LHS pool.
6. This summer community locker rooms will be added, the roof will be replaced, and also a big energy efficient project will be taking place as a new heating and cooling system will be installed.
