## Sally Kissner, “Inside the Arts Council”

The Arts Council is a 501c3 non-profit originated January 23, 1976 by Marie McIntosh and Don Nepper with the original name Community Arts Council of South Wood County, Inc. Its first office was in McMillan library and as of 2009 is located in the Northcentral Release complex on 8<sup>th</sup> street.

The mission of the Arts Council is to promote and encourage the existing cultural and educational organizations of South Wood County and its environs., to assist in the establishment of new cultural facilities in fields where none now exist, to coordinate the cultural and educational activities of the South Wood County and its environs so as to avoid overlapping and duplication of efforts, and to receive and disburse funds to implement the foregoing objectives.

Arts in Education: Arts in Education is integral to the mission of the Arts Council. Each year, the Arts Council works to foster programs which allow professional artists to enrich the lives of area students through performances, workshops, and master classes. These programs provide opportunities for students to develop their own creativity through personal contact with professional performers. The Arts in Education program for the 2016-2017 season included a DRUMLine Live master class for students from local music programs with the music director and several cast members. Students from area school districts had the opportunity to talk with the artists and learn from the experience of these touring performers. KIDS From Wisconsin held a free outreach on July 17 at the PAC with workshops on dance, music, lights, and sound.

Selecting programs is a collaborative effort and is done regionally in conjunction with other arts organizations to avoid duplication. Entertainers are typically secured based on audience preferences and cost between \$8 – 22K depending on the demand. Ticket fees are based on the performer feeds, accommodations, other expenses and the estimated ticket sales. Prices for this coming season range from \$31-\$46.
