Major Shane Blazer, Wisconsin Rapids Update

Shane grew up in Wisconsin Rapids and is a Lincoln High School graduate with a criminal justice and spent many years on the Wisconsin Rapids police force. He was on city council, then became city clerk, and now major. His first day was during COVID when there were very few people in the building. They are currently reviewing city position descriptions. Several areas are seeing compression where people don't want to take a promotion since they would make less. They are also looking at necessary remodels at the fire station that now have female firefighters.

He is a part of the Wisconsin Rapids Together workgroup that is looking to keep the Verso mill going. The website is <https://legis.wisconsin.gov/rapidstogether>
The mill has now shut down. The latest meeting included experts on Co-ops and how the timber industry is setting them up and how they might be formed to help purchase the mill for local control. Ace Hardware is an example of non-agricultural Co-op. USW Has an agreement that that union will go with the mill. Former employees will have access to insurance for the rest of the year.
