## Avenues of Service

Each committee was tasked with identifying their activities and recommended budget for the coming year.

### International

- Activities include Shoulder to Shoulder scholarship (\$500), exchange student (\$1,000), disaster relief (\$1,000), and polio plus (\$1000)
- Budget recommendation total is \$3500

### Community Service

- Activities include Foster Love, Neighborhood Table, Royal Family Kids, RAK Infant Needs, and the South Wood County Humane Society
- Recommended budget is \$1,500

### Club/Membership

- Activities include the Christmas party December 7<sup>th</sup>, curling event in March, Mini-Golf in July, and a cook-out at Bob Ebben's home in August.
- Budget recommendation is \$350

### Vocational

- Activities will include Youth Rotar scholarship, board to make selection from applications
- Need to budget for two RYLA students, the Youth Rotar Scholarship, and the youth world event in June
