Program – Liz Gosse, Youth for Christ, Juvenile Justice Program

YFC JJM seeks to engage young people as they are met in a variety of youth-serving institutions (detention centers, probation, correctional facilities, group homes, residential treatment centers and emergency shelters). These valued relationships are sustained through ongoing involvement as they reenter their communities. Liz works with children 11-17 years old in the Portage County detention center, typically 2-8, more male than female, and reflects the community diversity. Most of these kids have ACEs (Adverse Childhood Experiences) of 7 or more. These kids have overcome a lot to survive as long as they have. Some have learned to pay utility bills at the age of 5 or how to call 911 when their parents overdose. The key is to build positive relationships with these kids. Data indicates those that have been in the system have an 87% recidivism but only 25% if they have just one caring adult influence in their lives. Everyone agreed that she is doing amazing, needed work and is greatly appreciated!
