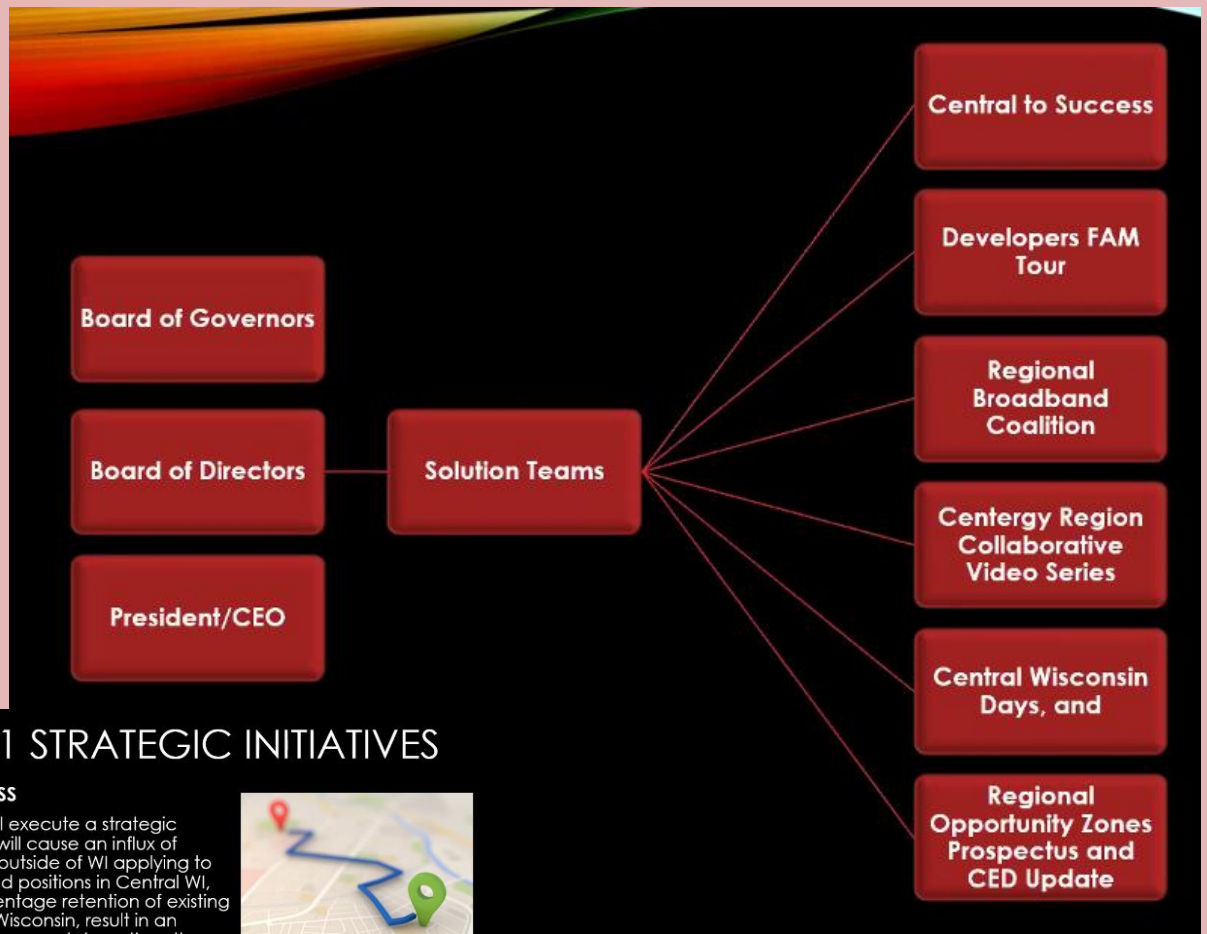
Gordon Crow, Centergy Regional Economic Development
