The presentation started off with a pop quiz from the first presentation. The answers were the Love INC mission to the right, that it takes a minimum of six different denominations to start an affiliate, that the initiative works for a long term, "teach them to fish" relationship-building root-cause approach, and works with other area support organizations in addition to the partner Christian churches.

Updates from the last presentation include the expanded board which now represents eight separate denominations. The organization has filed for its 501c3 status and has received confirmation from the IRS that the review is in process. They also have a new location, 3624 8th Street South next to MobilLink and Awards 'n More.

Materials presented were a new brochure, a copy of the September newsletter with a listing of the various churches that have received presentations and those that have signed the "Statement of Understanding" or "SOU", and a copy of the SOU. When asked how many members see their churches on the list about a third of those in attendance were represented. Members were encouraged to share the newsletter and SOU with their church if not already on the list.
