Maribeth Crawford “Love INC Update”

Love INC (Love In the Name of Christ) mission is to mobilize local churches to transform lives and communities in the name of Christ. Maribeth is the new Church Mobilization Coordinator working with over 16 partner churches to share the mission. Since formation in 2016, hundreds of clients have been helped and for many it has been the first time anyone has ever prayed for them.



The building blocks for the Love INC ministry uses a model of building a house. The foundation is the clearinghouse which is the call center where clients call for help. Once needs are accumulated, gaps are identified in community services and partner churches are mobilized to address the gaps. Currently there are several gap ministries active including a moving ministry, household item ministry, with efforts to start an addiction recovery ministry. Transformational ministries include training and education. The first classes will start this fall called “Affirming Potential” which helps identify individual God-given gifts that are meant to be shared and used. www.loveincswc.org
