### Kyle Cronan – Port Edwards School District

Kyle toured the group through the remodeled High School and Middle School. It is currently the oldest school in Wood County with the auditorium from 1920 and the main building from 1932. There have been a number of improvements of late. The first one of note was the front steps which are made of limestone that were deteriorating but with a sealing treatment look new. The hall floors had tiles that had been worn so much they were coming up. They were stripped and the concrete shaved and sealed for a great new look (see pic). The basement art room was completely remodeled after decades and is now a clean slate for that department. Two of our members, Kristopher and Dean were students at the school (Dean shared a note from one of his teachers, see pic).
