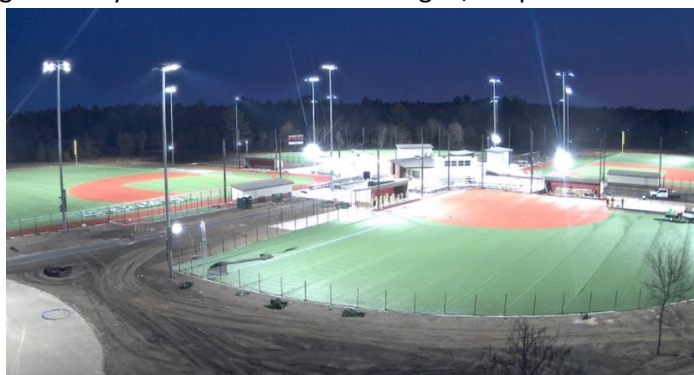

Ron Rasmussen Quadplex/Referendum Update

Ron has been the Lincoln High School principal for ten years now and is functioning as the project manager for the Quad-Plex and the building renovations from the \$34 million referendum that was passed in April. The referendum is a comprehensive plan designed to keep Wisconsin Rapids Public Schools thriving and adapting by impacting all students and all schools. The referendum addresses district-wide needs in the areas of safety and security, educational space improvements, and operational needs. Specific improvements include Lincoln High School science lab renovations and an addition for a new library/student resource center, construction of a gymnasium at THINK Academy (Rudolph Elementary), as well as capital maintenance and building infrastructure improvements. Below is a photo of the current status of the Quad-Plex which includes two baseball and two softball fields. It is expected to be ready for play this spring. Already a new adult baseball league, "Rapids Red Hawks" is planning on Playing there as well.
