The Lake Wazeecha White Sands beach shelter is a wonderful improvement and can be reserved for birthdays, graduations, or other gatherings and has a kitchenette and bathrooms. Dexter park has had additional camping sites for ATV/UTV campers with upgraded electrical. There have been many additions and improvements to ATV/UTV trails as well as single-track bike and snowshoe trails. At Powers Bluff, the highest elevation in Wood County, they are planning on expanding the area by 223 additional acres. The addition will provide a number of additional opportunities which includes preserving 70 acres as a natural area with sugar maples that provide a full canopy and some unique fauna.
