Megan Duellman – IT Security

Megan is a Technical Documentation and Online Training Analyst at University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and works remotely from her home in Port Edwards. She covered concepts to keep us safe from cyber scams. She covered a number of ways that scammers attempt to break-in or steal identities.



- **Phishing** - the fraudulent practice of sending emails purporting to be from reputable companies in order to induce individuals to reveal personal information, such as passwords and credit card numbers.
- **Vishing** - the fraudulent practice of making phone calls or leaving voice messages purporting to be from reputable companies in order to induce individuals to reveal personal information, such as bank details and credit card numbers.
- **Smishing** - the fraudulent practice of sending text messages purporting to be from reputable companies in order to induce individuals to reveal personal information, such as passwords or credit card numbers.

Most importantly is the use of difficult to break passwords. See the table on what it takes to break your password from a simple 6 lower case letter password that can be cracked instantly to a complex 12 character password that would take years to crack. She also recommended the use of passphrases using characters such as using “W@!k+h3d0g” instead of “walkthedog” and using password managers.
